Charles P. "Charlie" Tabler, 80 of Naples, FL (formerly of Hamilton, OH), passed away at his residence on Thursday, March 24, 2022. Charlie was born in Hamilton, Ohio, on January 26, 1942, to Albert E. Tabler and Hilda (Gardner) Tabler.

Charlie attended Hamilton Catholic High School and The University of Cincinnati. He started his career in material handling, became an engineer and ultimately owned his own company within the industry. He was responsible for over 20 patents. He retired in 2010.

His hobbies included fishing, golf, woodworking, stone carving and playing the piano. He also enjoyed cooking and gardening and was an avid card player. He was the author of 2 books. Throughout his life, he was consistently active in his parishes. Most recently, he held the position of HOA director of Turnberry Woods in The Strand for the last 10 years.

Survivors include his beloved wife of 58 years, Rita C.
