



## Dr. Adel El-Deiry

January 9, 1933 - May 16, 2017

Dr. Adel El-Deiry, 84, deeply beloved, husband, father and friend, passed away on May 16th 2017.

He was born on January 9, 1933 in Cairo Egypt. Adel immigrated to Canada in 1968 and then the United States in 1975. He is a medical graduate of Ein Shams University in Cairo and completed his residency training in Ear, Nose, and Throat Surgery from McGill University in Montreal.

Adel touched many lives in over 50 years of medical practice. Dr. El-Deiry was devoted to his patients who loved him for his open and honest bedside manner. He was never too busy to take the time to explain what was going on and would delight in patients' improvement both great and small. Adel continued to see patients at the Fort Meyers VA clinic up until four months before his death.

Dr. El-Deiry moved to Estero with his wife of 42 years, Lorraine, in 2002. He adored the game of golf and could be seen on his community course several times a week. Adel was genuinely warm and kind with everyone that he met. Words cannot describe how much he will be missed.

He is survived by his wife Lorraine (nee Widders), his sons, Mark, Paul and Chris, their wives Deonne, Marci, and Natalie, and grandchildren Julian,
