January 14, 1922 - March 22, 2016

Albert Byrel Marsh, 94, of Bonita Springs, FL, died Tuesday, March 22, 2016. He was a former resident of Niagara Falls, NY and Dayton, PA. He was born January 14, 1922 in Dayton, PA, the son of the late Albert and Veda (née McGaughey) Marsh.

Mr. Marsh graduated from Dayton Senior High School in Dayton, PA, Class of 1940 and attended the University of Pittsburgh. He was a World War II veteran, serving in the U.S. Army Air Force, U.S. Army Air Corps and the Combat Engineers. He fought at the Battle of the Bulge. He was employed for over 44 years at Olin (formerly Olin-Mathieson and Mathieson Chemicals), retiring in 1985 from the Instrumentation Department. He was a member of the Olin Sterling Club.

Mr. Marsh is survived by his loving wife, Beverly Ora (née Sarsfield) Marsh; his loyal son, John C. Marsh Sr. and wife, Patricia White Marsh of Bonita Springs, FL; beloved grandchildren, John C. Marsh Jr. of Tampa, FL, Jeffrey P.
