Ana M. Machamer 77, of Estero died Thursday, November 28, 2019 at Joanne's House at Hope Hospice. Ana was born February 26, 1942 in Hamburg, Germany a daughter of the late Claus O. and Elisabeth (Otzen) Schulz. She had been a resident of Bonita Springs or Estero for the past 14 years coming from Atlanta, GA.

When Ana was just 6 years old her family moved to Venezuela where she grew up. She came to the United States as an exchange student when she was 15 years old and couldn't speak any English. She graduated from Garinger High School in Charlotte, NC and spent 3 years at the University of Miami in Coral Gables, FL.

She met her husband, David D. Machamer while a student at the University of Miami and they were married April 14, 1962 in Coral Gables. David and Ana moved to Orange County California where Ana owned and operated Courtyard Travel in Tustin, CA for 10 years. She sold the company when they moved to Atlanta, GA.

She was a former member of the Pelican Landing Golf Club in Bonita Springs. She was also an accomplished bridge player and loved to play golf and tennis. Ana loved traveling and went on more than 50 cruises throughout the world. She also volunteered at the Salvation Army and the VITA program that

is a United Way function for the preparation of income taxes for low-income families.

She is survived by her loving husband of 57 years, David D. Machamer of Estero, FL; son, John D. Machamer (Erika) of Knoxville, TN, daughter, Elisabeth J. Machamer (Shellie) of Bend, OR; two brothers, Ricardo Schulz (Ypsi) of Fort Worth, TX and Juan Schulz (Mariluz) of Maracay, Venezuela; and two sisters, Maren Zietzschmann (Andreas) of St. Georgen, Germany and Susana Ascione (Armando) of Naples, FL.
