Anna G. Falk, 77, of Naples, FL, went to be with the Lord on Tuesday, December 19, 2017. Formerly of Naperville, IL, she had been a Bonita Springs resident since 1994. She was born February 12, 1940 in Kearney, NJ, the daughter of Wilbert Eugene and Anna (née DeYoung) Skold.

Anna graduated from Avon Grammar School, Asbury Park High School, Monmouth College and received her Masters Degree in Teaching from Kent College.
