Arthur W. Weber, Jr. 87, of Estero, FL died unexpectedly at his residence on Sunday, September 2, 2018. He was born May 1, 1931 in Hazelton, PA, a son of the late Arthur W. and Cecelia (née Murphy) Weber, Sr. A former resident of Safety Harbor, FL, he has resided in Naples and Estero since 1986.

He was a graduate of St. Bonaventure University in Olean, NY, class of 1953. He then served in the United States Marine Corp during the Korean Conflict.
