January 12, 1931 - December 2, 2022

Arthur L. Woody 91, of Bonita Springs, died Friday, December 2, 2022 at his residence with his loving wife by his side. Art was born on January 12, 1931 in Bagnell, MO to Arthur and Naner Woody (nee Beamer). In 1934, his family moved to Glassboro, NJ where he grew up and joined the Marine Corps during the Korean War. He was part of the Inchon Invasion and was one of the Chosin Few. Later, in Voorhees, New Jersey, he established Precast Specialties, Inc., a company that became one of the largest precast concrete erectors in the northeast covering five states specializing in commercial structures.

He married Virginia (Ginny) Sigethy in 1969, and they moved to Naples, FL where he purchased and managed Naples Beef & Beer while constructing 57 commercial offices/warehouses in J & C Industrial Park. At 2180 J & C Blvd., he formed/operated Asphalt Maintenance Enterprises which performed site work, paving and maintenance for construction in Collier and Lee Counties. Upon retirement, he became associated with Ginny's mortgage and real estate companies.

Art is survived by his wife, Virginia M. Woody; his sons: Arthur J. Woody (Bettyann), Brien K. Woody, and Michael T. Woody; seven grandchildren: Jim (Ann); Robbie, Melissa, Jason (Erika), Steven (Alicia), Branden, and Danielle. Nine great-grandchildren: Skylar, Luna, Tommy, Tyairra, Cayden, Siena, Nico,

Kamren, and Jordan. He is preceded in death by his son, Steven J. Woody and his daughter, Nancy C. woody.
