Betty Titus Sprouse, 90, of Naples, FL, passed away peacefully on Friday, May 23, 2025.

Born on January 7, 1935, in Marianna, Pennsylvania, she was the beloved daughter of the late Bertrand D. and Elizabeth J. (née Midla) Ulery. Betty led a full and remarkable life, defined by her dedication to family, faith, education, and service.

She was a graduate of the Andrews School for Girls in Willoughby, OH, and went on to earn a Bachelor of Music degree in piano from the Cleveland Institute of Music. On November 19, 1955, she married Charles I. Titus at the First Methodist Church in Warren, OH.

Throughout her life, Betty lived in many places, including Nashville, TN, where she worked for several years as a paralegal. In 1974, she and her family relocated to Winter Haven, FL, later moving to Texas, and eventually settling in Tallahassee, FL in 1984. There, she began a distinguished career with the State of Florida, serving as the Director of Education for the Florida Forestry Division until her retirement in 1997.

A woman of deep faith, Betty was a devoted member of Fellowship Presbyterian Church in Tallahassee, where she joyfully sang in the choir. She was also actively involved in civic and political life, serving as President of the

Republican Women's Club of Tallahassee and later as President of the Republican Women's Club for the State of Florida.

In addition to her public service, Betty found great joy in the arts and leisure. She was an avid bridge player, loved ballroom dancing, and was known for her gracious presence and warm heart.

She is survived by her three loving daughters: Cynthia L. Ford (John T. Ford III) of Naples, FL; Deborah Evans (Ronald Evans) of Durham, NC; and Patricia Titus-Spiegel (David Spiegel) of Tallahassee, FL. She also leaves behind six cherished grandchildren and ten great-grandchildren, who were a source of great pride and joy.

A memorial service for Betty will be held in Tallahassee at Fellowship Presbyterian Church details will be announced in the next week. Additional services and interment will take place at Crown Hill Burial Park in Vienna, OH, and will be announced at a later date.
