Carl L. "Bud" Castilow Jr., 83, of Bonita Springs, FL, passed away Wednesday, April 24, 2019. Formerly of Horseheads, NY, he had been a Bonita Springs resident since 1992. He was born June 14, 1935 in Wheeling, WV, the son of Sophie (née Dudzik) and Carl L. Castilow Sr.

Bud graduated from Triadelphia High School in Wheeling, then joined the United States Marine Corps.
