Caroline Peacock 71, of Fort Myers Beach passed away on Thursday, July 7, 2016. She was born October 7, 1944 in Millry, AL a daughter of the late Clarence L. and Florence A. (Bernice) Grimes. She had been a resident of Fort Myers Beach since 1993 coming from Clewiston, FL.

Caroline was a graduate of the Providence School of Nursing. In 1985, she opened her own home healthcare company, Home Care, Inc. The company's roots began in Hendry County and soon grew to include Charlotte and Lee counties. Her passion was being a RN and successfully operating her home health agency for 25 years.
