Charles Arthur “Chuck” McBirney 70, of Naples, FL lost his courageous battle with ALS on Saturday, March 28, 2020 at his residence surrounded by his loving wife and family. He was born February 6, 1950 in Cleveland, OH a son of the late Oscar and Constance (Balharrie) McBirney. Chuck had been a resident of Southwest Florida since 1976.

He met his wife, Susan Hecker in Pepper Pike, OH and they were married in 1973. Chuck had a long and distinguished career in the Air Conditioning industry which spanned over 38 years. He had a big impact on the HVAC community in Southwest Florida. In 1991, he started his own HVAC Company and retired from owning his own business in 2001. Not one to sit idle, in 2006 Chuck reentered the air conditioning industry on the wholesale side as a Manufacturer’s representative and was forced to retire in 2015 when he was diagnosed with ALS.

He was an avid Rotarian and a charter member of the Bonita Springs morning club for over 25 years. He twice served as the club’s President and was also a Paul Harris Fellow. He was awarded the Rotarian of the decade and had the privilege of being an Assistant District Governor for District 6960.

Chuck had a passion for sports whether watching on TV or playing and as time went on transitioned to umpiring. His true purpose in life was his loving

family.

He is survived by his loving wife of 46 years, Susan H. McBirney; their son and daughter-in-law, Justin McBirney and his wife, Michelle; his beloved grandson, Caleb McBirney all of Naples, FL; his brother, Jon McBirney and his sister, Constance Rendfeld and her husband, Ron.

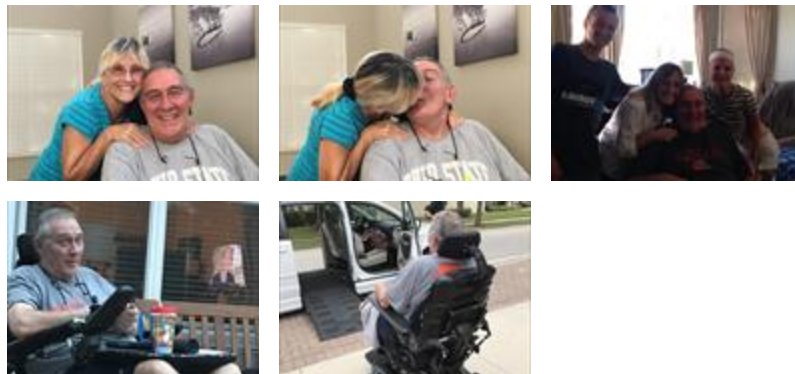

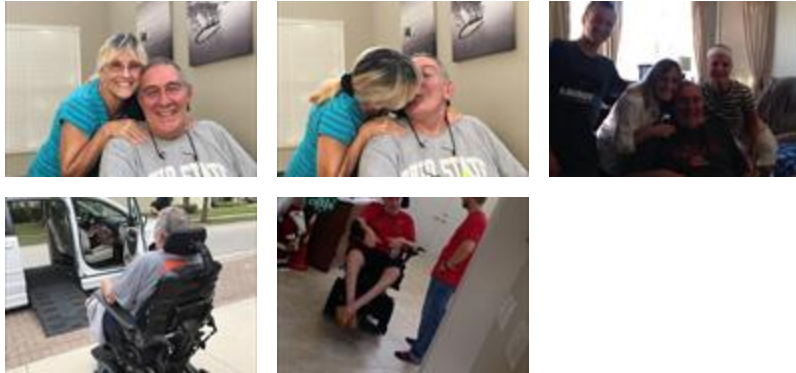
