Charles R. “Chuck” Peyla, 89 of Estero, FL passed away Monday, March 21, 2022 at Joanne’s House at Hope Hospice. Formerly of Joliet, IL he began wintering in Estero in 1999 before moving permanently in 2005. Charles was born July 3, 1932 in Joliet, IL a son of the late Louis R. and Caryl (Buck) Peyla.

Mr. Peyla was a Veteran of the United States Army, serving during the Korean War. He attended the University of Illinois and graduated from Illinois Wesleyan University, earning his degree in business administration.

In the early 1960’s, together with his brother, Chuck founded Illinois Securities Insurance in Joliet, spending his career as a broker until his retirement in 2005. Chuck served on the Board of Directors from 1973 – 2004 for the First National Bank of Joliet.
