Charles Henry "Chuck" Powars, 71, of Bonita Springs died Tuesday, March 17, 2015 at Joanne's House at Hope Hospice after a long courageous battle. Formerly of Hopkinton, MA, he had also lived in Proctorsville, VT before becoming a resident of Bonita Springs in 2000.

Chuck was born January 15, 1944 in Springfield, MA the son of the late John and Stanzerl (Edwards) Powars. As a Sergeant in the United States Air Force, Mr. Powars was an Air Traffic Controller during Vietnam. Chuck earned his Bachelor's Degree from the Clark University in Worcester, MA.
