



## Charles Richard Stone

Charles Richard Stone, 75 of Bonita Springs, FL passed away Tuesday, January 10, 2023 at Vitas Hospice. He Graduated from Lynnfield High in 1965. Formerly of Lynnfield, MA, Wellesley, MA and North Windham, ME he moved to Naples, FL in 2001 before relocating to Bonita Springs in 2004.

Charles was born May 1, 1947 in Lynnfield, MA a son of the late Henry Lewis and Ruth Elizabeth (Tyacke) Stone, Jr. He graduated from Wentworth Institute before a successful career as a project manager with major construction companies in Boston, MA, Portland, ME and Naples, FL. His most notable project was the USS Constitution Museum in Boston, MA.

Mr. Stone was involved in politics, while in Wellesley, he was an elected town meeting member, served on the planning board and was a committee member and superintendent of the cemetery at St. Mary's Episcopal Church. As a freemason, Chuck was Past Master of the Beth-Horon Lodge, Wellesley Lodge and the Lodge of Instruction in Massachusetts. He was also a member of Boston Aleppo Shrine

In North Windham, he was a member of the planning board, served as the Chairman of the Little Sebago Lake Association board and was a ski ambassador at the Sunday River Ski Resort. He enjoyed golfing, playing tennis, skiing, and fly fishing.

Chuck was an avid fan of Nascar & of all the Boston sport teams, esp. the NE Patriots. He also followed the Tampa Buccaneers. Chuck was a member of the Associated Builders and Contractors and was National Chairman head of the safety committee.

Survivors include his beloved wife of 54 years, Donna Marie (Devine) Stone; loving sons, Christopher (Danielle) Stone of Saco, ME, Alexander (Lauren) Stone of Westbrook, ME; and cherished grandchildren, Jack, Ryan, Gianna and Samuel. He will also be missed by his neighbors on Little Sebago Lake who he considered family. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his siblings, Henry Lewis Stone, III and Elizabeth Anne Stone.

A memorial service will be held in Lynnfield, MA at a later date and will be announced.

He will be laid to rest at Forest Hill Cemetery in Lynnfield, MA.
