Christine Dimelow, born Christine Cady, passed away on January 27 at the age of 55 after a brave battle with cancer.

Christine was born in Bethpage, New York, to Stanley P. and Mary Barbara Cady (née Clos) and grew up in Syracuse, where she spent much of her childhood. After the early loss of both of her parents, Christine was cared for by her aunt, Adrienne Clos. Over the years, Christine lived in several places that shaped her life—Syracuse, North Carolina, England, and finally Florida, where she made her home.

Christine worked as a dental hygienist at Bayside Smiles Dental Care. She took great pride in her work and was known for her compassion and the easy rapport she built with her patients.

She had an open spirit and enjoyed exploring meaning and reflection through practices such as tarot and working with crystals.
