



## Clement Franklin Stewart

December 15, 1933 - June 8, 2015

Clement Franklin Stewart, of Fort Myers passed away peacefully Monday, June 8, 2015 at Joanne's House at Hope Hospice with his family by his side. He had been a resident of Naples, FL since the late 1960's and moved to the Ft. Myers area in 1980. Clement was born December 15, 1933 in Moore County, NC a son of the late Lonnie A. and Myrtle L. (Yow) Stewart.

Mr. Stewart's 50 year career started at Pinehurst Golf Course in Pinehurst, NC, where he held many positions before becoming Golf Course Superintendent.
