Clifford “Max” Misner, 91, died Wednesday, August 3, 2016. Formerly of Terre Haute, Indiana, Max has been a Ft. Myers resident since 1989. He was born October 8, 1924 in Clark County, IL, the son of Clifford T. and Effie Viola (Horsley) Misner.

Max was a decorated U.S. Army veteran of World War II, serving primarily in the European Theatre, earning numerous valorous and individual awards including the Silver Star, Bronze Star, and Purple Heart.

After the war, Max worked for the Burroughs Corporation 30 years, then retired to his dream job of owning and operating the Twelve Points Village Hardware store in Terre Haute for another 20 years.

He is survived by his wife and childhood sweetheart, Audrey Ruth (Rollings) Misner; his children, Susan Chenoweth of Estero, FL, Kenneth (Rebecca) Misner of Tempe, AZ, and Scott Misner of Fort Myers, FL; sister-in-law Helen (Joab) Misner, and niece Martha (Rollings) Toth, both of Terre Haute; five grandchildren and nine great grandchildren.

Private services will be held by the family. Burial to take place in Roselawn Memorial Park, Terre Haute.
