Connie R. Sebring, 73, passed away peacefully on December 19, 2022, surrounded by her husband, daughter and granddaughter, at Joanne's House at Hope Hospice in Bonita Springs, Florida.

Born in Kermit, Texas, Connie was the eldest of two children born to Monte and Carol Mayfield. Connie's biggest joy was her family, especially spending time with her only granddaughter and family trips to Walt Disney World. She is preceded in death by her father, Monte H. Mayfield.
