



Dale Dungan Pullen

September 17, 1929 - November 1, 2017

Dale Dungan Pullen, beloved husband of Barbara, passed away on Wednesday, November 1, 2017. Dale was born on September 17, 1929 in Miami, FL to parents Olive Dungan (Composer and Concert Pianist) and Claude Pullen, early pioneer businessman and founder of Pullen Ironworks.

Among his many accomplishments, Dale graduated from Duke University and the University of Florida Law School, he also served three years in the United States Air Force reaching the rank of Lieutenant. He was a reporter-editor, Washington correspondent, recipient National Political Science Association, Congressional Fellowship, Congressional Liaison for Office for Civil Rights, Department of Education, and created and published with his wife, Barbara, "The U.S. Congressional Handbook."

After living in McLean and Great Falls, Virginia for 50 years, they retired back to the Florida he always loved and resided in Naples, Florida

His love of books and his love of The Constitution led him to write late in life the book: "The 17th of September, 1787 Constitution Day". Dale Pullen was a true patriot.

Dale is survived by his wife of 59 years, Barbara (Davison) Pullen of Naples, FL; two children, son, Claude John Pullen of Clearwater, FL, daughter,

Lorraine and husband, John James of Lovettesville, VA; two granddaughters, Carly and husband, Nate Tschohl and Candace and husband, Justin Holt all of Virginia Beach, VA; brother-in-law, Bill Davison and wife, Sue; sister-in-law, Bettijean and husband, Bill Meyer, 5 nieces, Kasey, Barbara, Marilyn, Jackie, and Valerie; 2 nephews, Chris and Jimmy all residing in Florida.

A private family service was held in their home in Naples and burial with full military honors was held at Woodlawn cemetery in Miami, FL on November 9, 2017.
