Damon Michael DeLorge passed away on June 13th, 2015 at Lee Memorial Hospital due to complications from Heart Surgery. He is survived by his mother, Barbara J. Cammarato of Fort Myers, FL, along with 4 brothers; Joseph G. DeLorge of Fort Myers, FL, Marc A. DeLorge of Garden Grove, CA, Christopher A. DeLorge of Las Vegas, NV, and Scott E. DeLorge of Olympia, WA. He is preceded in death by his father, Joseph G. DeLorge of Enfield, CT.

Damon was born in Norwich, CT where he resided until he attended college at Wentworth College in Boston, MA followed by Clemson University in Clemson, SC where he completed his Master's Degree in Architectural Design. Damon returned back to his Hometown to join an Elite Design Firm, where a number of his Designs were selected for the creation of various buildings within the Norwich area, as his talent and skill for drawing & design was truly revered.

After moving to Southwest Florida in 1993, Damon however found his True Calling after continuing to attend Church along with his grandmother with whom he lived and cared for in Sanibel. It was there that Damon realized his desire for Youth Ministry, beginning slowly at SCC, followed by many years of actively attending youth Conferences & Camps as well as going on Mission Trips, and eventually finding his Home years later at Summit Church in Fort Myers. It was there that he truly flourished in All Forms of Service, with his passion for Family Ministry & Youth Services leading the way, while also

regularly attending weekly Bible Study and Sunday Services. For over 2 Decades, Damon performed endless Service Work and counseled and inspired countless youth within the Fort Myers area, leaving behind the legacy of being the "Gentle Giant", who cared little for the material things as he cared rather to humbly serve God and spreading His gospel.

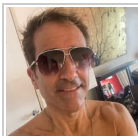

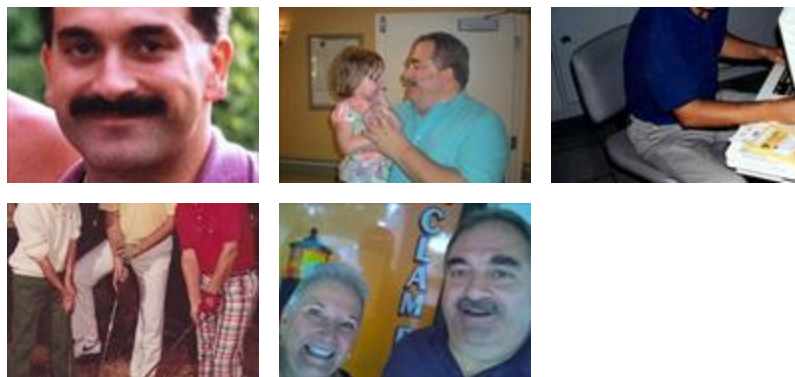
