David C. Mariconi 89, of Bonita Springs died Sunday, February 26, 2017 at his residence. He was born February 2, 1928 in Manhattan, NY a son of the late Luigi and Silva (née Di Clemente) Mariconi. A former resident of Butler, NJ he had resided in Bonita Springs for the past 8 years.

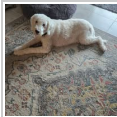
