



## Daymon C. Utterback

August 12, 1968 - September 29, 2022

Daymon C. Utterback, 54, known as the "pirate of Fort Myers Beach" died unexpectedly as the result of Hurricane Ian.

He was born August 12, 1968 in Indianapolis, IN the son of the late Carroll and Darline (Goodman) Utterback.

Daymon had worked as a mechanical engineer at EVERAXIS USA, Inc. in Naples for the past 11 years. He was well-known for his legendary pirate outfits and his likeness to Johnny Depp's character, Jack Sparrow, from the "Pirates of the Caribbean" movie series. Daymon also loved fishing for shark from the beach.

Survivors include his fiancé, Theresa Conway and her sons, Jesse (Natasha) Clark, Andrew (Amber) Clark and Rusty Clark; uncles, Terry L. (Janet) Goodman, Samuel R. "Dick" Goodman and Ferrell Utterback; aunt, Linda Hale; loyal Yorkshire mix, Peanut; and numerous cousins.
