Denis Krebs Dugan, aged 84, of Naples, Florida, passed away peacefully on Thursday, February 8, 2024.

Born on August 19, 1939, in Albany, NY, to the late Joseph and Dorothy Dugan, Denis was the cherished second son in a loving family. He attended Vincentian Institute and Diocesan HS, Brothers of the Holy Cross, graduating in 1957 before proudly serving in the Marines. His academic journey continued at Northeastern University, where he obtained a BS in Business Administration in 1964, followed by an MBA from American University in 1966. Denis's heart found its first match in Brenda Mary Aswad during a college break at Lake George. The couple wed on July 22, 1961, in Clinton Heights, NY, sharing a life full of love until Brenda's passing in 2015. Fortune smiled upon Denis again when he met Elizabeth (Ela) Maria Olech in Naples, FL, leading to their marriage on October 17, 2020.
