Diana C. Morrison (Lavigne), North Port, FL, currently residing in Naples, FL, passed away peacefully on Sunday, June 25th, 2023 at the age of 87. Born in Brockton, MA in 1935 to the late Alfred Lavigne I and Dorothy (Tinkham) Lavigne, she was the loving wife of the late Harold Morrison.

Raised in Brockton and a 1958 graduate of Brockton High School, Diana married and resided in Brockton with her family. In 1989, she moved to Plymouth, MA to their summer home on Ezekiel Pond and eventually retired to La Casa in North Port, Florida, where she was an active member of the Grandmother's Club and regularly played bingo and cards with her many friends.

Diana worked for Brockton Public Schools as a kindergarten aide for many years.

An avid golfer, she learned to play at D.W. Field Golf Course. She golfed countless times at Little Harbor Golf Course in Wareham, MA and at many other courses in Massachusetts and Florida and was proud of her four holes-in-one.
