He was freshman at Estero High School and since the age of 6 has been playing hockey. . He started his hockey career with the Florida Eels Hockey Team and also played four seasons with the Junior Florida Everblades as a defenseman. He rejoined the Florida Eels traveling team in 2012.

He also played lacrosse for the Gorilla Lacrosse Club in Estero. He enjoyed motocross and vacationing in Colorado. But most of all he was a character, making people laugh or playing a prank usually brought the biggest smile to his face.
