



## Donald Duane Bohn

February 26, 1933 - November 25, 2021

Donald "Don" Bohn, age 88, of Bonita Springs, FL, died peacefully after of brief hospital stay the evening of Thanksgiving, November 25, 2021.

Don was born on Feb. 26, 1933, in Olyphant, PA, the fourth child of Fred and Hazel Dudish Bohn. He attended Kings College in Wilkes-Barre, PA where he played football.
