



## Donald A. LeRoy

March 16, 1933 - June 21, 2017

Donald A. LeRoy, 84, of Estero, FL, passed away on Wednesday, June 21, 2017. Formerly of Auburn Hills, MI, he had been an Estero resident since 2011. He was born March 16, 1933 in Detroit, MI, the son of Emil T. and Ruth Madeline (née Pittinger) LeRoy.

Mr. LeRoy was a veteran of the U.S. Army – He served as a PFC during the Korean War. Upon returning he attended the University of Detroit, before becoming a Detroit Police Officer from 1956-1962. In addition, he was a dental executive for over 30 years before becoming the owner of Roydent Dental Products.

Mr. LeRoy is survived by his loving wife of 62 years, Margaret Anne (née Caringi) LeRoy; his beloved children, Michael (Marie) LeRoy of Livonia, MI, Carin (Brian) Dwyer of Ft.
