



## Edward A. Ingersoll

March 14, 1935 - October 18, 2019

Edward A. Ingersoll 84, of Bonita Springs, FL and formerly of Ft. Myers, FL died Friday, October 18, 2019 at his residence. Ed was born March 14, 1935 in Killbuck, NY a son of the late Howard and Edna (Geiger) Ingersoll. He had been a resident of Bonita Springs since 1980 coming from Canandaigua, NY.

Ed was a graduate of Killbuck High School and after graduation, he enlisted in the U.S. Army and served during the Korean Conflict. Once he returned home, Ed operated a farm for 10 years and then spent 25 years working at Goulds Insulator Factory in Rochester, NY.

After moving to Fort Myers he began building homes in the Fort Myers area and all over Lee County. He worked at Myerlee for over 30 years as a maintenance engineer and also operated his own company, Ingersoll Maintenance and Repairs until his health issues forced him to stop working in March of this year at the age of 84.
