Edward T. Palmer 68, of Bonita Springs, FL died unexpectedly on September 5, 2024. Formerly of Anderson, SC, he moved to Florida 40 years ago. He spent the first 7 years in Key West and the last 33 years in the Naples and Bonita Springs areas. Ed was born on September 10, 1955, in Atlanta, GA, a son of the late James R. and Ruby T.
