



Eileen Alyse Hallissey

July 4, 1942 - January 17, 2017

Eileen Alyse Hallissey, 74, of Naples, FL, passed away on Tuesday, January 17, 2017. Formerly of Millville, NJ, she had been a Naples resident since 2010. She was born July 4, 1942 in Philadelphia, PA, the daughter of William J. and Alyse (née Boyle) Tobin.

Eileen attended parochial schools in suburban Philadelphia before graduating Immaculata University in 1964. She began teaching elementary school for six years before joining her husband in various business ventures. Eileen was active in many charitable and civic organizations and served on the regional hospital board before becoming chairperson of the Inspira Hospital Foundation. In early 2000, she was made a Dame of St. Gregory by the Diocese of Camden, NJ. After moving to Naples in 2013, she became active in the St. William Catholic Church Respite Program until she became ill in 2014.

Mrs. Hallissey is survived by her loving husband of 50 years, William J. Hallissey; her beloved sons, Luke (Christi) Hallissey of Margate, NJ and Tim Hallissey of Los Angeles, CA; and two cherished grandchildren, Hailey and Ashleigh Hallissey.

A Mass of Christian Burial will be celebrated Saturday, January 28, 2017 at 11:00 a.m. at St. William Catholic Church, 601 Seagate Drive, Naples.
