Frank Cappadonia, 93, of Naples, FL, died on April 10, 2022, lovingly surrounded by his wife Ellen, and their four children. He was born on September 30, 1928, in Mt. Morris, NY. as one of 8 children to Sicilian immigrants, Salvatore and Gaetanna Cappadonia.
