Frank Joseph Flood, 84, of Naples, Florida, passed away peacefully surrounded by loved ones on November 14, 2023.

Frank was born in Queens, New York on October 4, 1939, a son of Frank and Ethal Flood. He graduated Bishop Loughlin MHS in Brooklyn New York. Frank was a scholarship athlete and played on his high school's basketball team. One of Frank's greatest passions was education. Frank is survived by 2 stepchildren, 4 grandchildren, his niece and nephew and his partner Ginny Schmidt.

Frank was preceded in death by his parents, siblings and his amazing wives Frances Flood and Patti Burrows.
