Frank S. Turek, Jr. 84, of Estero, FL died Friday, June 26, 2020 while under the compassionate care of Hope Hospice in Ft. Myers, FL. Frank was born on May 13, 1936 in Yonkers, NY the son of Frank S. and Lucy (Bird) Turek, Sr. He had been a resident of Estero since 2017 coming from Ft. Mill, South Carolina.

After graduating high school, Frank served in the U.S. Army from 1954 thru 1956. After returning home he attended Seton Hall University in South Orange, NJ on the GI Bill. Frank began his career with the Xerox Corp and later became Vice President of Dynamic Control's, Inc. in Manasquan, NJ. He left DCI in 1990 and founded the Austin Group, a consulting company and eventually retired in 2004.

He was a former member of Rotary International in New Jersey and a member of Our Lady of Light Catholic Community in Ft. Myers, FL. He is currently in the presence of the Lord having accepted the free gift of eternal life made possible by the sacrifice of Jesus Christ (John 3:16).
