Fred "Dahn" Cadby, 88, of Estero, FL passed away Friday, February 2, 2018 at Frances Georgeson Hospice House. Formerly of Carmel, IN, he began wintering in Naples, FL 25 years ago before moving permanently to Estero in 2000. Dahn was born February 18, 1929 in Indianapolis, IN the son of the late Fred and Imogene (Wills) Cadby.

Mr. Cadby was a veteran of the United States Army.
