



G. Malcolm Pratt

July 16, 1935 - January 16, 2026

Malcolm Pratt passed away peacefully Friday January 16th in Bonita Springs, Florida.

Malcolm was one of two sons born to George and Dora Pratt in Oxford, England. As a child, he remembered and survived the World War II bombings and air raids throughout England. His family moved to Sunderland, England, where he spent the majority of his youth and became an avid fan of the Sunderland Football Club.

When Malcolm was in his teens, he moved to Paisley, Scotland, where he met his future wife Mary at a local dance hall. Moving to North America, first to Toronto, Canada, then later to the United States in search of work, Malcolm and Mary would finally settle down in Detroit, Michigan, where they would have and raise their two children, Karen and Michael.

Malcolm worked for more than 30 years at Ford Motor Company in various engineering positions. In Michigan, he watched his two children grow into adulthood and start families of their own.

Malcolm and Mary later moved to Bonita Springs, Florida for retirement, where he was an avid golfer and world traveler with his wife. In the months leading up to his passing, Malcolm was able to celebrate his 90th birthday in

Las Vegas with all of his immediate family.

Malcolm is survived by his wife Mary; brother Alan; daughter Karen (husband George); son Michael (wife Janet); and his two grandchildren, Erin and Brenden.

A Memorial Service to celebrate his life will be held at 2:30 PM on Friday, January 23, 2026 at the First Presbyterian Church of Bonita Springs. A reception for family and friends will follow in the church hall.
