Rawson of Arlington, MA. Proud grandmother to six lovely granddaughters.

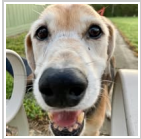
Services for Gayle will be held privately and at the convenience of the family.

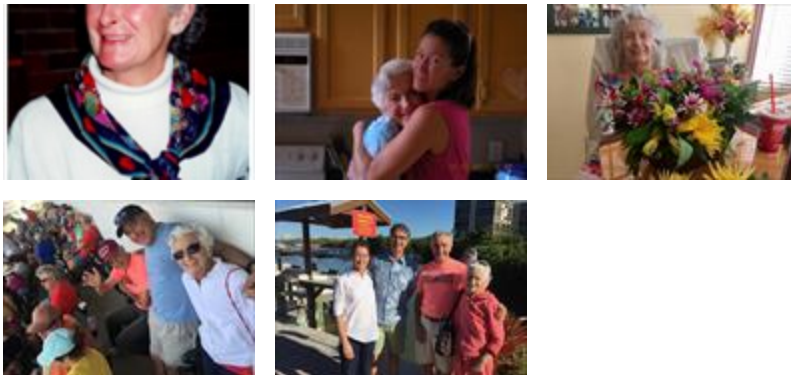
