George Harold Murray, 93, of Naples, FL, died Saturday, November 1, 2014. He was born March 9, 1921 in Hamilton, Ontario, Canada, the son of Arthur Hadley and Kate Henrietta (née Hodgins) Murray.

George was a World War II veteran of the U.S. Army Air Corps where he received pilot training. He spent most of his life in Rochester, NY and began his career with the Haloid Corporation that later became Xerox Corporation. He was responsible for the assembly line for the 914 copier, the first of Xerox's unique copying machines. He retired from Xerox after 30 years of service and began to spend winters in Naples, Florida at the Glades. He moved to Florida full time in 2003 as a member of the Glades community. He enjoyed golf and traveling with his wife Stella. In recent years, they moved to Terracina Grand where they could spend their days together.

Mr. Murray is survived by his loving wife, Stella Nasca (née Karpilo) Murray; his beloved children, Maureen (John) Secker of Bonita Springs, FL, George (Barbara) Murray Jr. of Bonita Springs, FL, Kathleen (Bob) Weingartner of Castle Pines, CO and Kevin (Trudy) Murray of Mount Holly, NC; eleven cherished grandchildren, Lauri, Kent, David, Tracey, Jeffry, Stacey, Michael, Peter, Jason, Matthew and Erin; and eighteen great grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by his first wife, June (née Martin) in 1983.

Services will be held in New York at a later date.
