Glen Albert Wurster widowed husband and beloved father and grandfather died Monday January 30, 2023 in Bonita Springs, FL at the age of 96. He was born on July 8, 1926 in Celina, Ohio, a son of the late Glen Dale and Thelma (nee Pichon) Wurster.
