



Glenn T. McKeever

March 23, 1924 - January 19, 2020

Glenn T. McKeever 95, of Estero, FL died January 19, 2020 at the HealthPark Hope Hospice. He was born March 23, 1924 in Gibson City, IL a son of the late William Earl and Pearl (Parr) McKeever. Glenn had been a resident of Bonita Springs and Estero since 1982 coming from Decatur, IL.

After high school graduation, Glenn served his country in the U.S. Navy from 1944 through 1946. He was an Electrician's Mate Third Class in charge of the ship's generators and the ship's communications. After his discharge, he attended both Purdue University and Kansas City State College on the GI Bill.

He was instrumental in the establishment of the first microwave communication system for Motorola in the early 1950s. In 1956, he established the McKeever Communication Company in Decatur, IL and operated the company until his retirement in 1980. After moving to Florida, he opened Tropicom Communications in North Naples until his final retirement in early 2000.

Survivors include his two loving sons, Kevin G. McKeever of Bonita Springs, FL and Craig T. McKeever and his wife, Angela of Bonita Springs, FL; his brother, Jim McKeever and his wife, Anita of California; his sister, Jane Shuler of Champagne, IL; 6 grandchildren, Bailey McKeever of Bonita Springs, FL, Kathryn Lane of Bonita Springs, FL, Elizabeth McKeever of Champagne, IL,

Sarah McKeever of Virginia, Matthew McKeever of Ft. Myers, FL and Michael McKeever of Bonita Springs, FL and 2 great-grandchildren, Evan Lane of Bonita Springs, FL and Keaton McKeever of Virginia.
