Harry James Stabile III (71) of Naples, FL passed away on November 1, 2021 after a heroic battle with cancer.

“Jim” was born in Medford, MA to parents, Harry James Stabile II and Eleanor Buttimer Stabile (both deceased). He is survived by his brothers John P.
