



## Harvey G. Humphrey

October 29, 1939 - January 22, 2016

Harvey G. Humphrey, 76, well-known and loved friend and businessman in Bonita Springs, FL, passed away unexpectedly on Friday, January 22, 2016. Born in Omaha, NE on October 29, 1939 to Joseph Bliss and Rachel Humston Humphrey, Harvey grew up in Valley, NE and attended Nebraska Wesleyan University in Lincoln where he became president of his fraternity, Phi Kappa Tau. While in college, he met and married the love of his life, Linda Hume of Tekamah, NE, with whom he enjoyed 53 years building a laughter-filled life and family. Harvey has two children, Lisa Kathleen (Kevin) Dolan of Estero, FL, and Mark Joseph (Teresa) Humphrey of Naples, FL, and six grandchildren: Justin Bryan Adams, Gavin Joseph Adams, Devin Robert Adams, Sarah Kathleen McKeever, Zachary Joseph Humphrey, and Keira Marie Humphrey.

Naturally business-minded, Harv (as all friends know him) began his career working as a salesman with Dow Chemical which allowed the family to enjoy Naperville, IL, Columbus, OH, and Boston, MA. While in Boston, he owned and manufactured Delta Life Jackets. In 1980, the family moved to Salt Lake City, UT where Harv began work selling Gilsulate for American Thermal Products, an underground pipe insulation company. During their stint in Utah, the family spent summers boating on Lake Powell and camping in the Uinta Mountain range. Nine years later, Harv and Linda purchased and relocated his business to Bonita Springs, where soon after the entire family arrived.

Wrapping up his extensive business ventures, Harvey built Hidden Beach Storage on Bonita Beach Road only a short time later.
