February 15, 1943 - May 24, 2026

Henry B. Bird, II, 83, of Bonita Springs, Florida, passed away on May 24, 2026, at NCH North Hospital following a brief illness.

Born on February 15, 1943, in Rockland, Maine, Henry was the son of the late Theodore Bird and Ruth (Lawrence) Bird. He spent many years in Freeport, Maine, before becoming a winter resident of Bonita Springs in 1993. In 2003, he made Bonita Springs his permanent home.

Henry was a graduate of Cushing Academy and the University of Southern Maine's Portland campus, earning his bachelor's degree. He proudly served his country in the United States Army during the Vietnam War from 1964 to 1967.

A respected businessman and dedicated community member, Henry owned and operated Bird Realty Agency in Freeport, Maine. After relocating to Southwest Florida, he founded Bird Realty Group, a successful business that he continued to operate until the time of his passing.

Henry was deeply committed to service and fellowship. He was an active Rotarian for more than 40 years with the Freeport, Maine and Estero, Florida Rotary Clubs. He was also a proud member of the Estero Elks Lodge #2753.

He is survived by his loving wife, Bobbi G. Bird of Bonita Springs, Florida; his

sons, Jeffrey H. Bird (Megan) of Portsmouth, Virginia, and James T. Bird of West Gardiner, Maine; his daughter, Suzanne V. Bird of Windsor, Virginia; and his stepson, Jason R. Heppe of West Bend, Wisconsin. He also leaves behind six cherished grandchildren: Isabel Bird, Everest Bird, Brayden Bird, Breanne Bird, Evan Heppe, and Izaac Heppe: as well as his brother, Lawrence Bird of Rockland, Maine.

In addition to his parents, Henry was preceded in death by his brother, William Bird of Rockland, Maine, and his stepson, Nicholas C. Heppe of West Bend, Wisconsin.
