December 21, 1931 - September 12, 2021

Howard Wayne Warner 89, of Estero, FL died on Sunday, September 12, 2021 at his residence. He was born on December 21, 1931 in Frederick, MD a son of the late Howard U. and Opal F. (Lanois) Warner. He had been a resident of Estero since 1994 coming from Rockville, MD.

He spent his elementary school years in Edgewood Arsenal, MD and his high school years in Havre de Grace, MD. From 1946 thru 1948 he attended the Fishburne Military School in Waynesboro, VA where he excelled in football, track and played saxophone in the band. He was a graduate of the University of Maryland and earned his BS in Political Science in 1952.

He was a veteran of the U.S. Air Force having served during the Korean War from 1952-1953 and was honorably discharged as a First Lieutenant.

In 1954, after returning from the war he began his career in the printing industry. He started as a Printing Production Assistant at Judd & Detweiler, Inc. In 1957, he became the Asst. Production Manager and wrote a textbook "Planning for Better Imposition." In 1960, Wayne became an Account Executive where he broke all company sales records in his first year. He worked with Jackie Kennedy in producing White House Guide books, instrumental in founding the U.S. Capitol Historical Society, Washington Monument Assoc., National Zoo coloring book series and many others. In

1970, he became Assistant Vice President and in 1980 President of Judd's, Incorporated; and Director, of all Judd companies. After 35 years, Wayne retired in 1988.

His printing industry achievements included Vice Chairman, Printing Industries of America, Inc., President, Conference Board of Major Printers, President, Education Council, Board member and fellow, Graphic Arts Technical Foundation, President and recipient, Distinguished Service Award, Printing Industry of Metropolitan Washington, Inc.

He is survived by his wife, Judy D. Warner of Estero, FL; daughter, Lisa W. Bacon and her husband, Robert of Ashburn, VA and two grandchildren, George Patrick Bacon-Cox and Emily Kathleen Bacon.

He was preceded in death by his first wife, Dolores H. Warner who died in 2018, and his son, Craig H. Warner.
