Jack Hazen, 92, of Bonita Springs, Florida, passed away peacefully on August 21, 2023, after a long and fulfilling life. He is survived by his loving wife Patricia, daughters Karen Brothers (Jerry), Jill Hazen (Robert Liles) and son Peter (Laurie); his grandchildren and great grandchildren, along with many nieces and nephews.

He was born in the Bronx, New York, in 1931, to Louis and Florence (Abravaya) Hazen. His two brothers, Albert and Herman, and sister, Rae, have all predeceased him.

Jack attended Emory University and graduated from the University of Miami. He served in the U.S. Army stateside during the early years of the Korean War. After the war, Jack began his career as a marine biologist in the Florida Keys. He later changed careers and moved to Wilmington, Delaware, where he worked as a court reporter for the Delaware Superior Court. In the early 1970s, he obtained his real estate license and served as a real estate broker and developer for many of the most notable real estate firms in New Castle County, Delaware. He retired from real estate in 1998 after a 25+ year career and moved to Naples, Florida, with his wife, Patricia.

He was active in tennis and his church; he also had a passion for classical music, travel and his cherished dogs, Jessie and Nandi.

Jack was a loving husband, father, grandfather and great-grandfather. He got his greatest joy being with people and was always willing to help others. He was known for his sense of humor and his love of life. He will be deeply missed by all who knew him.

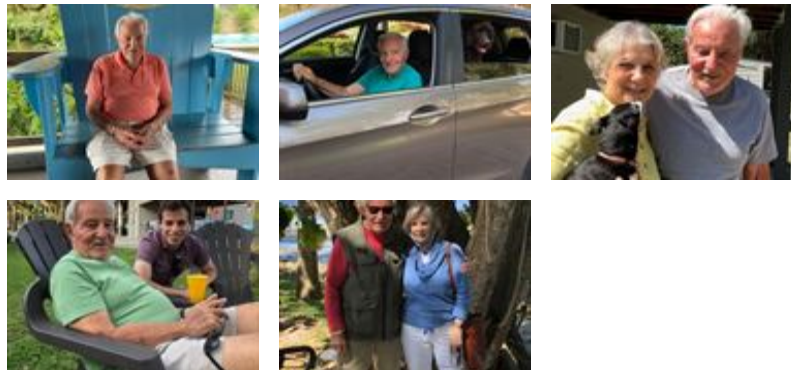
