James P. "Jim" DeCarlo, 99 of Naples, FL passed away Wednesday, August 31, 2022 at Vitas Hospice. Formerly of Baltimore, MD he had been a resident of Naples since 1983. He was born September 24, 1922 in Baltimore, MD a son of the late John and Caroline (DiSante) DeCarlo.

Mr. DeCarlo enlisted in United States Army in 1942 and served as morse code operator in the Indian Ocean Campaign during WWII. After obtaining the rank of Sergeant Major, he then served in the Army Reserves Military Intelligence and was appointed to the rank of Chief Warrant Officer 4. He served his country for 30 years.

Jim earned his Juris Doctorate at the University of Baltimore School Of Law before working as an attorney for the City of Baltimore Solicitor's Office from 1953 – 1983.

He loved listening to and singing opera as well as traveling the world with his wife.

Survivors include his beloved wife of 28 years, Eileen (Graham) DeCarlo; and loving sons, James J. DeCarlo of Naples, FL, Peter A. DeCarlo of Fort Lauderdale, FL and Daniel J. DeCarlo of the Philippines. In addition to his parents, Jim was preceded in death by his first wife, Catherine DeCarlo in

1983; and nine siblings.
