James Bernard "Jim" Golden, Jr., 67, of Estero, FL died unexpectedly on Friday, June 12, 2020 in Naples, FL. Formerly of South Windsor, CT he had been an Estero resident since 2004. James was born September 9, 1952 in Hartford, CT, a son of the late James B. and Celia J. (Maloney) Golden, Sr.

He attended Manchester Community College before pursuing his career in law enforcement. Mr. Golden served as a police officer at the Hartford Police Department in Hartford, CT for over 24 years. He then worked at the University of Connecticut Health Center Police Department before retiring from law enforcement. During retirement, he worked as a realtor at Keller Williams Elite Realty in Bonita Springs.

Jim was also a devout catholic and parishioner of Our Lady of Light Catholic Community where he was very active in the Knights of Columbus Council 10498, serving as Past Grand Knight and member of the 4th Degree.

Survivors include his loving children, James B. (Tina) Golden III of Ponte Vedra, FL, Jennifer M. (Craig) Kline of Trade, TN, Jeffrey Golden of FL; siblings, Deidre (Steven) Davies of Bolton, CT, Sean Golden of Spain, Kevin (Brenda) Golden of Ireland; and cherished grandchildren, Eva, Marlo, Torin, Adelyn, Katelyn and Grace.
