James E. Hogan, 84, of Bonita Springs, FL, and a former resident of Teaneck, NJ, died on Saturday, September 28, 2024, at his residence. He was born on June 30, 1940 in Lynn, Massachusetts a son of the late John J. and Alberta (née Hunt) Hogan. Jim had been a resident of Bonita Springs since 2009, coming from Teaneck, NJ.

He was a proud veteran of the U.S. Marine Corps, having served from 1957 – 1960. After his military service, he began his career in the chemical industry. He started his 30 years working for Reichhold Chemical in Massachusetts before transferring to NJ. As a working adult, he earned his bachelor's degree by attending classes at night. After leaving Reichhold, Jim was hired by Lenape Industries in Teaneck, NJ, as their President and finally retired in 2009.

He is survived by his loving daughter, Laure Ann McCloskey (Ron) of Bonita Springs, FL; his beloved son, Lee J. Hogan (Lori) of West Alexander, PA; his brother, John J. Hogan, Jr. of Massachusetts; his sister, Jane Hogan of Illinois; his two grandchildren, Anna Ponce Ricks and Zachary Ponce. He is also survived by his 7 great-grandchildren, Roman Ponce, Max Ponce, Xavier Ponce, Elijah Ricks, Finn Ricks, Delilah Ricks, and Julian Ricks.

his sister, Joyce Kaes.
