Jane Elizabeth Harteis, 72, of Estero, Florida, died Saturday, January 31, 2015. Formerly of York and later Biglerville, PA, she had been a seasonal Estero resident since 2006. She was born July 13, 1942 in York, the daughter of Robert Elwood and Annabel Mae (née Allison) Kline. She graduated from her beloved York High School in 1960, Elizabethtown College in 1964 and enjoyed a 30 year career as a medical technologist at the York Hospital.
