Jean E. Conklin, a former cherished resident of Bonita Terra (formerly Citrus Park) in Bonita Springs, passed away on July 2, 2024, in Naples, FL. She was born on April 16, 1930, in Monsey, New York, and was the devoted wife of the late Raymond J. Conklin who passed away in 2007.
