



## Jean C. Van Buren

December 8, 1922 - March 29, 2015

Jean C. Van Buren 92, of Naples, FL died Sunday, March 29, 2015 at the Bentley Care Center after a brief illness. Born December 8, 1922 in Short Hills, NJ, she was a daughter of the late Albert L. and Marguerite (Haas) Cole. Jean had been a winter resident of Marco Island since 1982 and a full time resident of Bentley Village in Naples since 2000.
